



## EVANSVILLE PHILHARMONIC YOUTH ORCHESTRA CONDUCTOR

**Status:** Part-time, exempt position.  
Position starting August 2024.

**Reports to** Evansville Philharmonic Orchestra Music Director. The EPYO Conductor works closely with the EPYO II Conductor and the Director of Education.

### **Responsibilities**

The Evansville Philharmonic Youth Orchestra Conductor shall perform all requisite duties including, but not limited to the following:

- Serve as Conductor for all EPYO rehearsals and concerts
- Take full responsibility for planning coordinating EPYO programs under the supervision of the EP Music Director
- Recruit new members for EPYO annually
- Attend EPYO Parents Auxiliary Group meetings when needed
- Actively work with the Orchestra's Development and Marketing departments on Youth Orchestra fundraising, marketing, and public relations activities
- Judge entrance auditions and seating auditions during the season
- Conduct all EPYO rehearsals
- Conduct a minimum of two EPYO concerts, one in the fall and one in the spring, and conduct additional concerts as developed
- Be able to meet a variable schedule, including evenings and weekends
- Manage communication with students and parents collaboratively with the Education Director and/or the Ensemble Manager
- Prepare and distribute music and resources as needed
- Collaborate with the EP Music Director on occasion during rehearsals or for inviting to guest conduct EPYO students

### **Other Information**

The Evansville Philharmonic Youth Orchestras provide an excellent musical education, enabling youth to realize their creative potential and enriching their lives. In existence since 1993, the Evansville Philharmonic Youth Orchestra program, with approximately 70 members, is a subsidiary of the Evansville Philharmonic Orchestra and consists of a high school orchestra (EPYO) and a middle school orchestra (EPYO II).

The goals of the Evansville Philharmonic Youth Orchestras are:

- To provide opportunities for public and private school students in the Tri-State area to perform orchestral music
- To educate students to pursue high standards in the performance of orchestral music
- To cultivate young talent, that these students may be enriched as both performers and listeners
- To assist, stimulate, and encourage schools in their development of instrumental programs
- To function as a community outreach, sparking interest in orchestral music throughout the Tri-State and beyond

Candidates will be required to conduct the Evansville Philharmonic Youth Orchestra additionally as part of the interview process. Conducting interviews will begin in April 2024.
