The Evansville Philharmonic Chorus (EPC) announces the following auditions for the 2025-26 season:

- Saturday, August 9, 2025, 10:00 12:00 PM

Auditions will be held at Trinity United Methodist Church, located at 216 SE 3rd St, Evansville, IN 47713. Please be prepared to sing from the audition materials below.

Auditions are by appointment only. To be scheduled, please send your preferred audition date, vocal part, and any questions to Craig Branch (cbranch@evansvillephilharmonic.org). Final audition recordings will be provided once your audition is scheduled and confirmed.

Audition Materials

You will sing the following piece starting and ending where indicated. You will sing with the audition recording labeled with your voice part. The audition recordings have the other 3 parts. For example, if you are a soprano, you will sing using the soprano audition recording. The alto, tenor and bass will be played on the recording, and you sing the soprano part. The learning tracks are only for helping you learn your part. They will not be used in the audition.

You will also be asked to sight-read a short rhythmic exercise.

There will not be a designated place to warm up so you will need to do this prior to arriving at Trinity. Please bring your music, along with your completed audition form. The audition recordings will be provided.

Ave verum corpus, natum de Maria Virgine, vere passum, immolatum in cruce pro homine: Cuius latus perforatum, Unda fluxit sanguine. Esto nobis praegustatum in mortis examine: O Dulcis, O pie, O Jesu fili Mariae, miserere mei. Amen.

Hail true body, born of the Virgin Mary.
Truly suffering, was sacrificied on the cross for mankind,
From whose pierced side flowed blood,
Be for us a foretaste in the final judgment.
O sweet, O merciful, O Jesus, Son of Mary,
Have mercy on me. Amen.
