Per service pay scales for 2019-2020 Season are: Assistant Concertmaster \$109.61 and Section Musicians \$ 88.92. The corporation pays mileage at half of the government rate with carpooling incentives; and provides hotel [double occupancy] for consecutive services.

The Evansville Philharmonic Orchestra is a regional orchestra that performs 6 Classics and 4 (double) Pops concerts each season. A series of *Messiah* performances, youth concerts and other events are included in each season. The EPO sponsors two Youth Orchestras and a 100+ voice adult chorus.

Alfred Savia is celebrating his 31st year as the conductor and Music Director of the Evansville Philharmonic Orchestra. This season the Evansville Philharmonic will have five conductor

candidate finalists including Laura Jackson, Scott Seaton, Michelle Merrill, Charles Latshaw and Roger Kalia.
